



IBDP ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

The Universal School through its, ‘**IBDP Academic Scholarship Program**’, offers the opportunity to meritorious students to be a part of its rich learning environment that appreciates the merit in Academics. Existing students of The Universal School and new students seeking admission for IBDP (Grade 11) are eligible to apply for this Scholarship.

Eligibility criteria for IBDP Academic Scholarship:

The eligibility criteria are strictly based on the Board Results (Grades 10). The details of the qualifying standards and percentage of scholarship are listed in the Grid below:

The scholarship is offered to students in IBDP 1 and to be eligible for the continuation of the scholarship in IBDP 2, the student must score as per the above table in IBDP 2. A scholarship Cheque/DD equivalent to the eligible amount shall be issued upon declaration of the IBDP 2 Results. Students can improve their performance and become eligible for a higher percentage of scholarship in the second year and in the case of a drop in the performance the category of the scholarship will also dropdown.

General regulations governing the scholarship plan:

- The scholarship amount is strictly restricted/calculated only on the Tuition Fees as per the Fee Structure of the grade. All other applicable fees are payable by the student.
- All decisions for the selection of students for the scholarship are at the discretion of the management and no representation will be accepted.
- Intimation of the scholarship will be made in writing signed by the management representative. No oral confirmation should be considered.
- The management at any time may withdraw scholarships offered without giving any notice. Students who have joined the school under the scholarship plan will be allowed to continue their education under the scholarship program for the Academic year in progress.
